Sir,

Enclosed herewith please find a list of the Miami's who are expected to emigrate, as soon as I can possibly do so. I shall give you the name and age of each individual.

I have had the honor to receive from two letters of the 14th, one acknowledging the receipt of my monthly returns, the other accompanying a Proclamation of the President of the United States. I shall strictly observe your directions in relation to my intercourse with the Miami's.

The Contractor for the emigration of the Miami's is now collecting them at a point about 10 miles north of Pens. Ind., and expects to be able to start some time during next month.

I have not been able to get the name and age of each Indian, but I have given you the number as given to me by the chiefs in council, and I presume you will find it very nearly correct, enough so to enable you to make a division of their names without doing injustice to either portion of the tribe.

I explained to the Chief the object of taking this list, and the importance to them of getting it correct.
