




Know all Men, that We, Eliza A Sedgwick John Moorhouse

administrators. Sealed and dated the 27 day of March 1880

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Eliza A  
Sedgwick shall faithfully discharge the duties  
of his trust as Administrator with the will annexed  
John Sedgwick of the Estate of  
deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
