Know all Men, That we Samuel Warner & Joseph Warner Junior and George Lump are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of Three Thousand Dollars, for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 22<sup>th</sup> day of September 1871

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Samuel Warner & Joseph Warner Junior shall faithfully discharge the duties of their <sup>of his</sup> trust as Administrator of the Estate of Joseph Warner Sr deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
