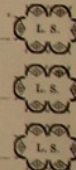


Know all Men, that We, George Martin of Nagerton J. Bauer

are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of Two hundred Dollars, for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 12th day of November 1878.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound George Martin shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of Peter Ladig deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
