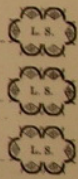


Know all Men, that We, Rauford Parker and Perry A. Raudall are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of Ten Thousand Dollars, for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 26 day of March 1870.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Rauford Parker shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of John P. Chaplin deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
