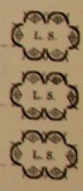

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Stephen Emmerhiser shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of Mary Emmerhiser deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
