Sealed and dated the 26 day of September 1879.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Francis Hamilton shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of John Hamilton deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
