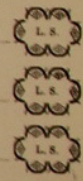


Know all Men, that We, Alfred D. Bressler Jane Murray

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Alfred D. Bressler shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of Kerr Murray deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
