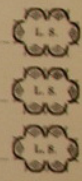


Know all Men, that We, George Fry, Adam Marquardt and Charles E. Richards

are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of six hundred Dollars, for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 30 day of January 1882.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound George Fry shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of Paul Bagnat deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
