


Know All Men, That we, John Middleton and David Casselman are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of One Thousand dollars for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 24 day of January 1854.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound John Middleton shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as administrator of the estate of John Borran deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
