


Know All Men, That we, William Long and John Snyder are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of Four Thousand dollars for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 12 day of August 1854.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound William Long shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as administrator of the estate of Sarah A Long deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
