The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound William G Ewing & George W Ewing
shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust
as administrator with the will annexed of the estate of William G Ewing
deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be
void, else to remain in full force.
