




Know All Men, That we, Christian Piepenbrink

 administrators. Sealed and dated the 22 day of December 1854.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound  
Christian Piepenbrink shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust  
 as administrator of the estate of Christian  
Baade deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be  
 void, else to remain in full force.
