Sealed and dated the 17 day of March 1856.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Francis Frieschtenecht shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as administrator of the estate of Christian Mueller deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
