administrators. Sealed and dated the 5 day of June 1856.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound
Nathan Coleman shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust
as administrator of the estate of
William Meyer deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be
void, else to remain in full force.
