Sealed and dated the 2 day of June 1857.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound John R. Hart shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as administrator of the estate of George Brown deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
