 for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and  
 administrators. Sealed and dated the 4 day of April 1859.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound  
Orata Jekins shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust  
 as administrator of the estate of Charles  
Jekins deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be  
 void, else to remain in full force.
