




Know all Men, That we, William M. Litch and Benjamin M. Litch

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound William M. Litch
 shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust
 as administrator with the will annexed of the estate of John M. Litch
M. Litch deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be
 void, else to remain in full force.
