Sealed and dated the 22 day of June 1861.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Anthony McBroue shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as administrator of the estate of Peter Maloue deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
