Sealed and dated the 23 day of June 1862.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Catharine McDonald shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as administrator of the estate of Phillip McDonald deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
