**B**know All Men, That we, William Grava and Henry Grava

are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of One thousand dollars for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of October 1857.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound William Grava and Henry Grava shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as administrator of the estate of Frederick Grava deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
