

Know all Men, That we, Sarah Smith and John

Smith are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of two thousand dollars, for the payment of which we, jointly and severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 12 day of June 1858.

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Sarah Smith shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as administrator William S. Smith of the estate of deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
