are bound to the State of Indiana in the penal sum of Five Hundred Dollars, for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 12th day of August 1867

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Henora Gibbon shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of John Gibbon deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
