Know all Men, That we James McCrory and George Henderson

are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of Eight hundred Dollars,
for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators.
Sealed and dated the 3rd day of May 1875

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound James McCrory
shall faithfully discharge the duties
of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of
Abraham Fulkerson
deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
