

Know all Men, That we Charles Cartwright and Perry A Randall are bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of One Hundred Dollars, for the payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators. Sealed and dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July 1876

The Condition of the above Obligation is, That if the above bound Charles Cartwright shall faithfully discharge the duties of his trust as Administrator of the Estate of John C Cartwright deceased, according to law, then the above obligation is to be void, else to remain in full force.
