

The Matter of the Estate of Robert P Brownell deceased³
 Be it remembered that on this 13th January AD 1845 came into the Clerk's
 office Daniel Rickman & Nathaniel Brownell next of kin of said deceased and
 relinquish their right of administration on said estate & request that John S
 Archer & Jeremiah Kyle be appointed administrators of said estate and
 therefore said Archer & Kyle pray that letters of administration be granted
 unto them and the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court being satisfied that Brownell
 has been deceased for more than fifteen days last past and the said John S
 Archer having filed bond in the penal sum of six hundred dollars with
 Nathaniel Brownell & Philip Clerk as his securities, which bond was
 approved of by said Clerk & the said Jeremiah Kyle having filed a
 bond in the penal sum of six hundred dollars with Nathaniel Brownell
 and John H Klunger as his securities which bond was approved of by
 said Clerk & said Archer & Kyle being filed in the office of said Clerk
 the oath requiring by law Letters of administration was granted in due form
 by Philip G Jones Clerk of the Probate Court in & for the County of Allen in the
 State of Indiana do hereby certify that administration of the goods & chattels
 rights credits monies and effects which were of Robert P Brownell late
 of Allen County deceased who died intestate is granted to John S Archer
 and Jeremiah Kyle and the said John S Archer & Jeremiah Kyle
 having qualified and given bonds as such administrators are duly authorized
 to take upon themselves the administration of said estate according to law

The Matter of the Estate of William Parent deceased
 Be it remembered that on this 29th January 1845 came into the office of the
 Clerk of the Allen Probate Court John B Dubois praying that letters of admin-
 istration on the estate of William Parent be granted unto him and the said Clerk
 being satisfied that said Parent has been dead for more than thirty days last past and the
 said John B Dubois having filed bond in the penal sum of three hundred dollars with William
 H. Brown as his security, which bond was approved of by said Clerk & the said John B Dubois
 having filed his oath in the office said Clerk Letters of administration was granted in due form
 by Philip G Jones Clerk of the Allen Probate Court in & for the County of Allen in the
 State of Indiana do hereby certify that administration of the goods & chattels, rights credits
 monies & effects which were of William Parent late of Allen County deceased who
 died intestate is granted to John B Dubois and the said John B Dubois
 having qualified & given bond as such administrator is duly authorized to take upon
 himself the administration of said estate according to law
