

In the Matter of the Estate of Patrick Scanlon ?  
 Be it remembered that on this 4<sup>th</sup> February 1845. Came into the office of the Clerk  
 of the Allen Probate Court Julian Benoit & prays that letters of administration on  
 the estate of Patrick Scanlon be granted unto him and the said Clerk being satisfied  
 that said Scanlon has been dead for more than fifteen days last past and that said  
 Benoit having filed bond in the sum of three hundred dollars with Henry Colwell  
 as his security, which bond & security is approved by said Clerk and said Benoit  
 having filed as part as such administrator letters were issued as follows to wit  
 I Philip G. Jones Clerk of the Probate Court in & for the County of Allen in the  
 State of Indiana do hereby certify that administration of the goods & chattels  
 rights, credits, moneys & effects which were of Patrick Scanlon late of Allen  
 County deceased who died intestate is granted to Julian Benoit and the  
 said Benoit having qualified & given bond as such administrator is duly  
 authorized to take upon himself the administration of said estate according to  
 law. Witness my hand & the seal of said Court this 4<sup>th</sup> Feb'y 1845 (30) P. G. Jones Clerk

In matter of the Estate of Ezra Royall ?  
 Be it remembered that on this 18<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1845. Came into the  
 office of the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court John Rough Jun & filed therein a  
 renunciation of the right of administration on said Estate by Elizabeth Royall  
 the widow of said deceased in these words (to wit) and thereupon said Rough  
 prays that letters of administration on said estate be granted unto him, and  
 the said Clerk being satisfied that said Ezra Royall had been dead for more  
 than fifteen days last past and said John Rough Jun having filed bond in  
 the sum of sixteen hundred dollars with Saml. Keanna as his security  
 which bond was approved of by said Clerk & having also filed his oath as  
 such administrator letters were issued as follows, to wit: I Philip G. Jones  
 Clerk of the Probate Court in & for the County of Allen in the State of Indiana  
 do hereby certify that administration of the goods, and chattels, rights, credits,  
 moneys and effects which were of Ezra Royall late of Allen County  
 deceased who died intestate is granted to John Rough Jun and the said  
 Rough having qualified and given bond as such administrator is duly  
 authorized to take upon himself the administration of said estate ac-  
 cording to law - Witness my hand & the seal of said Court this 18<sup>th</sup> Feb'y A.D. 1845
