

The Matter of Estate of John Chapman deceased

Be it remembered that on this 2^d April 1845 comes before the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court John Barclay & files the following affidavit (in) 1, which it appears that unless a special administration of the estate of said John Chapman deceased late of Allen County, Indiana be granted that the same may be lost by the exclusive intermeddling with the said estate & that there is no person having authority to take of said estate wherefore he prays that special letters of administration be granted unto him & the said John Barclay having filed and in the first term of these numerous court with Leysman Williams as his security, which bond & security is approved of by the said Clerk letters of administration were granted him in these words to wit

I Philip G. Jones Clerk of the Probate Court in & for the County of Allen in the State of Indiana do hereby certify that John Barclay is true, appointed Special administrator of the goods & chattels, rights & credits, monies & effects which were of John Chapman late of said County of Allen deceased who died intestate to look after collect preserve the property of said intestate until demanded by the person due, authorized to administer the same & having duly qualified & given bond as such administrator he is duly authorized to take upon himself the administration of said estate according to law Witness Philip G. The Matter of the Estate of John Edman deceased

Be it remembered that on this 14th April 1845 comes before the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court Mary D Edman & prays that letters of administration on the Estate of said John Edman late of said County of Allen be issued to grant her and the said Clerk the being satisfied that said John Edman has been dead for more than fifteen days last past & said Mary D Edman having filed bond in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars with John E. Sile & William G. Ewing as security which bond & security was approved of by said Clerk & having filed the oath required by the statute as such administrator letters of administration were granted her in these words to wit

I Philip G. Jones Clerk of the Probate Court in & for the County of Allen in the State of Indiana do hereby certify that administration of the goods & chattels, rights & credits, monies & effects which were of John Edman late of Allen County deceased who died intestate is granted to Mary D Edman and the said Mary D Edman having qualified & given bond as such administrator is duly authorized to take upon herself the administration of said estate according to law
