

The Matter of Estate of John Chapman deceased

Be it remembred that on this 2^d April 1845 comes before the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court John Ward & his wife the following Appointee (his) to whil't it appears that during Specie administration of the estate of said John Chapman deceased late of Allen County, Ohio, he granted that the same may be looked by the court intermeddling with the same estate that there is no person having authority to take of said estate whereupon he says that Specie letters of administration were granted unto him & the same John Ward having filed and in the period sum of three months thereafter with Lyman Williams as his security, whil't said security to approve of by the said Clerk letters of administration were granted him in these words to wit:

I Philip G. Stone Clerk of the Probate Court in & for the County of Allen in the State of Ohio do hereby certify that John Ward is duly appointed Specie administrator of the goods & chattels right credits monies & effects which are of John Chapman late of said County of Allen deceased who died intestate to look after care & disposal the property of said intestate until Administrators of the person dead, authorized to administer the same & having due qualification given him as such administrator he is only authorized to take upon himself the administration of said estate according to law witness Philip G. Stone Clerk of said Court at the court house this 2^d April 1845 P.G. Stone U.C.

The Matter of the Estate of John Easom deceased

Be it remembred that on this 14th April 1845 comes before the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court Mary D. Easom & sons that letters of administration on the estate of said John Easom late of Union County of Allen deceased be granted her and the said Clerk being satisfied that said John Easom has been dead for more than fifteen days last past I said Mary D. Easom having filed same in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars with John Eddie & William Easom as security whil't said security was approved of by said Clerk & having filed the same required by the state to said administrator letters of administration were granted her in these words to

I Philip G. Stone Clerk of the Probate Court in & for the County of Allen in the State of Ohio do hereby certify that administration of the goods & chattels right credits monies & effects which were of John Easom late of Union County deceased who died intestate is granted to Mary D. Easom and the said Mary D. Easom having qualification given her as such administrator is only authorized to take upon herself the administration of said estate according to law
