

The matter of the Estate of Philo Whitcomb deceased
 July 1845 comes into the office of the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court Mary Whitcomb
 one of the creditors of said Estate & prays that letters of administration be granted to her
 said Philo Whitcomb being granted unto her & the said Mary Whitcomb being
 sworn on her oath & enters that the personal estate of said deceased does not exceed
 one hundred dollars, five dollars & the said Mary having filed bond in
 the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars with William Cain as his security
 which bond & entry is approved of by the Clerk of said Court & the said
 Whitcomb being sworn for more than fifteen days last past letters were
 issued in these words (the said Mary having taken & subscribed an oath as
 such an administrator) To wit

I Robert C. Fleming, Clerk of the Probate
 Court in for the County of Allen in the State of Missouri do hereby certify
 that administration of the goods chattels rights credits monies & effects
 which were of Philo Whitcomb late of Allen County, deceased who died
 intestate is granted to Mary Whitcomb and the said Mary Whitcomb
 having qualified & given bond as such an administrator is duly authorized
 to take upon herself the administration of said Estate according to law
 within my hand & the Seal of said Court this 4th day of July 1845 in the year
 of our Lord 1845 (50) R.C. Fleming Clerk

The matter of Estate of William R. Pindrop

Be it remembered that on the sixth day of
 August 1845 comes into the office of the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court William Writche
 one of the creditors of said Estate & prays that letters of administration be granted to him on
 said Estate and the Clerk being satisfied that said Pindrop has been dead for more
 than thirty days last past & that the personal estate of said deceased in this County
 does not exceed two hundred dollars & the said William Mitchell having filed bond
 in the sum of five hundred dollars with Jesse S. Williams as his security which
 said bond & security are approved of by the Clerk of said Court & the said Mitchell having filed
 his oath as such administrator letters of administration were issued in these words (To wit)

I Robert C. Fleming, Clerk of the Probate Court in for the County of Allen in the State of
 Missouri do hereby certify that administration of the goods chattels rights credits monies &
 effects which were of William R. Pindrop late of Montgomery County, New York deceased
 who died intestate and the said William Writche having filed qualified & given bond
 as such an administrator is duly authorized to take upon himself the administration of said
 Estate according to law within my hand & the Seal of said Court in the
