

The matter of the Estate of William Welch

Be it remembered that on the 17<sup>th</sup> July 1845 came into the office of the Clerk of the Allen Probate Court Dennis Duncanson Esq. a Letter of Administration on said Estate in granted unto him and the said Clerk being satisfied that the said Welch has been dead for more than fifteen days last past and the said Duncanson being fully versed in the penal Statute of two hundred and thirty six Statute in that behalf made and the said Clerk being sworn to and the said Clerk of said Court & having sworn to & subscribed an oath to file the same which said oath is in these words (viz) Letters of Administration were issued in this case to wit I Robert C Fleming Clerk of the Probate Court in for the County of Allen in the State of Indiana do hereby certify that Administration of the goods & chattels rights credits monies & effects which were of William Welch late of Allen County deceased who died intestate is granted to Dennis Duncanson and the said Dennis Duncanson is duly authorized to take upon himself the Administration of such estate according to law Witness my hand and the seal of said Court this 17<sup>th</sup> July in the year of our Lord 1845 R.C. The matter of Estate of Dennis G Thompson deceased

Be it remembered that on this 4<sup>th</sup> September 1845 came into the office of the Clerk of Probate Court in for the County of Allen Joseph Scott Esq. Washington & John George Esq. and in the application for Letters of Administration on said Estate of Dennis G Thompson deceased and now file in said office a renunciation of the office of said Clerk and request that said Court Washington & George be appointed which renunciation is in these words (viz) and the said Joseph Scott now file a bond in the penal sum of twenty thousand dollars with Charles E Stanger Raphael P Jones & Francis J. Abert as his securities and the said Esq. Washington now file a bond in the penal sum of twenty thousand dollars with Charles Paige Ranger W Taylor & Thomas Fitchard as his securities and the said John George he file a bond in the penal sum of twenty thousand dollars with Gamuel Hanna & John E. Hill as his securities, which said several bonds with the renunciations thereon are approved of by the Clerk aforesaid & the said Joseph Washington & George having filed their separate oaths as such Administrators Letters of Administration are issued in these words to wit I Robert C Fleming Clerk of the Probate Court in for the County of Allen in the State of Indiana do hereby certify that Administration of the goods & chattels rights credits monies & effects which were of Dennis G Thompson late of Allen County deceased who died intestate is granted to Joseph Scott Esq. Washington & John George Esq. and the said Esq. Washington & George being qualified & sworn are duly authorized to take upon themselves the Administration of said estate according to law Witness my hand & the seal of said Court this 4<sup>th</sup> Sept 1845 in the year of our Lord 1845 R.C.
