 to the satisfaction of the Clerk that the said Edward Rockhill has been
 dead for more than thirty days last past. And the said Rebecca
 Rockhill having filed bond in the penal sum of Eight Hundred Dollars
 with Isaac D. Nelson as her security thereon. And the said Joshua
 Holmes having filed bond in the penal sum of Eight Hundred Dollars with
 S. Bayless as his security thereon, which bonds & securities are approved of by the Clerk
 and the said Rebecca & the said Joshua having filed their oaths as such
 Administratrix & Administrator & which bonds & oaths respectively are in these
 words (to wit) Letters of Administration were issued in these words:
