The Estate of Nathan Ferrand, Dec'd.

Comes now into the Office of the Clerk of the Probate Court in & for Allen County, Indiana on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1846 Franklin P. Randall prays that letters of Administration on said Estate be granted him and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Clerk of said Court that the said Ferrand has been dead for more than fifteen days, & it also appearing that the widow of said decedent has renounced her right by her renunciation in these words (viz) - And the said Randall having filed a bond in the penal sum of Two Thousand Dollars with Samuel Hanna as his security, the said bond & security are approved by the Clerk, and the said Randall having also filed an oath as such Administrator, according to law, which bond & oath are in these words (viz) Thereupon letters of Administration are issued in these words to-wit -
