 Court of Allen County, Indiana,  
 Now Comes into the Office of the Clerk of the Probate  
 Court of Allen County, Indiana, on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September 1846 Edward Moulfingher & sprage that letters of Administration on the said Estate be granted him not appearing to the Clerk of the Probate Court of the said County of Allen in the State of Indiana aforesaid that the said Seyberlich has been dead for more than fifteen days last past, & that said decedent has left no kin residents of the State of Indiana aforesaid. And the said Moulfingher having filed a bond in the Probate Court of the said County of Allen in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars with Samuel Stappler and Louis Hitzfield as his securities thereon, which bond securities are approved by the Clerk of the said Court, and the said Moulfingher having filed his oath as such Administrator, according to law which bond & oath aforesaid are in the words & figures following to-wit: (he)  
 I Edward Moulfingher do hereby certify that letters of Administration of the good & lawful rights credit monies & effects which were of Charles Seyberlich late of Allen County Indiana who died intestate is granted to Edward Moulfingher; and the said Edward Moulfingher having filed qualified and given bond as the said Administrator is duly authorized to take upon him self the administration of such estate according to law - Witness my hand & the seal of said Court this 25<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty six

The Estate of Aaron Besby and  
 Now comes into the office of the Clerk of the Probate Court of Allen County, Indiana on this 29<sup>th</sup> September AD 1846 Rebecca Besby widow of said decedent & sprage that letters of administration on said estate be granted unto her and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Clerk of the said Court that the said Aaron Besby has been dead for more than fifteen days last past and the said Rebecca having filed a bond in the Probate Court of the said County of Allen in the sum of four thousand dollars with George N. Ashley & Ralph Johnson as her securities & having filed the oath required by law which bond & oath are in these words (she)  
 I Rebecca Besby do hereby certify that letters of Administration of the good & lawful rights credit monies & effects which were of Aaron Besby late of Allen County who died intestate is granted to Rebecca Besby and the said Rebecca Besby having qualified & given bond as such Administrator is duly authorized to take upon herself the administration of such estate according to law - Witness my hand & the seal of said Court this 29<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord 1846
