They were chosen to suit the reading needs of all those attending Miner, and to provide a variety of reading materials for all aged groups from pre-primer through the elementary grades.

In this manner the child can select his own books but at the same time the teachers are given an opportunity to direct good reading tastes. Coupled with the program of the urban library service it is felt that the library program at Miner is top-grade.
