

No child is taken or sent from the building without first receiving permission from the child's parents. This permission should be in writing and filed with the principal in the school files. Exceptions to this case would be in case of child injury when medical care is necessary and contact with the parent is impossible. Any necessary medical care in this case is requested of a family doctor and the child is taken to the doctor by the Principal, incase moving the child will not further increase his injury.

Relative to a child getting milk at school:

Milk is purchased by any child whose parent wishes it, and the period of serving milk at school is during the first portion of the morning recess time. Milk orders are taken only on the weekly basis on Friday mornings. Each child is responsible for his own milk every day as there is no way of making up for children who forget or are not here for their milk.

Relative to children not being allowed in the building before a certain time and not being permitted to go to classrooms until a certain time:

The school day for the children begins at 8:30 in the morning and 1:30 in the afternoon. A period of 20 minutes before either beginning time seems sufficient amount of time for any child in coming to our school. In order to give ample time for class preparation and notices to be placed on the blackboards children are asked to go to the auditorium if they enter the building at 8:10 or 1:10 and remain there until 8:20 or 1:20 when they may go to their rooms.

Relative to the use of the building by any organization such as Scouts, etc:

Building permits for organizations wishing to hold meetings after 5 o'clock in the evening are secured from Mr. Rodemeyer's office at the School Administration Building. Four meetings for the P.T.A. use are paid for by the School City, for all other meetings a charge is made which is payable to the office when an application for building use is made. Upon making application rooms requested for use are specifically stated on the permit issued for the school with times given for use that evening. Any use of the building previous to or past that time are overtime and are chargeable by the hour.

(Postscript by Mr. Rice: "Obviously many of the regulations a school is required to make seem difficult and even to the point of infringing upon certain rights of people. However logical those arguments for special permissions and excuses may seem, the school only asks that it be remembered we are dealing with the children from all families and wish to do the best possible for all children at all times. We do not claim to treat all children alike but hope that it might be said we have dealt with each child fairly.
